

Cleaning Performance Fabrics

Revolution (Olefin) fabric:

To prevent soiling, regularly vacuum your Revolution upholstery without the brush attachment. Steam cleaning is reccomended as preventitive maintenence. Do not launder or dry clean.

- For general messes, remove debris and blot up moisture imeadiately. If needed, use a vacuum without the brush attachment to remove small solids. Use a desposible bleach wipe to buff out the area (or a baby wipe for oil-based stains). With a spray bottle, soak the area in clean water and blot out again using a clean cloth.
- For stains, clean with a solution of 1/2 tablespoon bleach to each cup of water. Use a spray bottle to easily disperse the solution and wet the area. Wipe with a clean cloth to blot up the stain and moisture. Saturate the area with clean water to rinse the bleach solution out of the fabric and blot again with a clean cloth. Allow the fabric to air dry.
- For stubborn or oily stains, repeat the above process with a solution of 1 tablespoon bleach and 1 tablespoon of dish detergent to 1 cup of water. Take care to get all soap residue out.

Crypton and Sunbrella treated fabrics:

To prevent soiling, regularly vacuum your treated upholstery. Steam cleaning is reccomended as preventitive maintenence. Do not dry clean or treat with bleach.

- Remove debris and blot up moisture imeadiately. If needed, use a vacuum to remove small solids.
- Begin the treatment of oily stains by sprinkling with cornstartch to soak up oils. Remove with a straight edge or by vacuuming.
- Prepare a cleaning solution of 1/4 teaspoon mild enzyme detergent or dishwashing liquid per 1 cup of lukewarm water. Apply the cleaning solution using a spray bottle. **Do not oversaturate**. Let the solution soak before lightly scrubing the area with a sponge or soft bristle brush. Rinse out the brush frequently as you buff out the stain. Rinse area after cleaning to remove all soap residue. Blot with a clean cloth and allow to air dry. Repeat process as needed.
