

To repair vintage vinyl:

Taking care to use a flat work space, begin by using a heavy duty tape to secure and mend the tear from the back side.

From the front of the floor cloth, slightly bend to expose the tear.

Apply super glue to the inside edges of the torn area.

Lay vinyl flat and cover with an aditional length of tape.

Let sit for at least 30 minutes to cure. After curing period, remove tape from top of vinyl.

If necesary, to disguise sheen from glued area, buff very gently with steel wool. Be advided that accesive buffing may remove some ink.

Leave tape on back of vinyl to keep the mended area secure.
